LOCAL ADVISORY COUNCILS

Purpose:

- 1. To promote community awareness of the Mediation Center of Eastern Carolina (MCEC) mission and its programs
- 2. To organize and implement local fundraising activities

Membership

Advisory Councils will include members of the MCEC Board of Directors and staff from the geographic area served, as well as local community members. Board members serving on the Council are accountable to the MCEC Board of Directors for the Council's activities.

Advisory Council Member Responsibilities:

- 1. Become knowledgeable about the Mediation Center and its programs. Attend at least one program offered by the center each year.
- 2. Attend regularly scheduled Advisory Council meetings and be prepared to participate in discussions at the meetings.
- 3. Represent the Mediation Center to individuals, the public, and other organizations. Promote the center's outreach services to local businesses, government, and professionals in the community. Assist with public relations activities.
- 4. Develop and carry out annual fundraising activities to raise the amount recommended by the MCEC Board of Directors.
- 5. Make a personal financial contribution to the Mediation Center of Eastern Carolina each year.
